"So if it got lost, there's not really anything I could do, but I can actually log in and put in the receipt number for my ballot and see if it got processed."

ADLER OPTED TO NOT REGISTER HER MAIL THIS YEAR IN ORDER TO SAVE MONEY, BUT HAS DONE SO IN THE PAST IN ORDER TO TRACK THE MAILING PROCESS.
